Literary Club

Literary club is formed to develop the speaking and writing skills of the students. Throughout the year various activities and competitions are organized like Debates, Elocution, speeches, storytelling, talk shows, seminar, quiz, symposium, dialogue conversation etc in which the children learn how to use correct intonation and pronunciation. The literary club promotes writing skills by organizing story writing, poem writing, slogan writing, and report writing, paragraph writing, article writing activities in the school.

Literary Incharges:- Literary Incharges are assigned to manage literary activities and enhance the literary skills of the students. They inspire them to develop a taste for literature & improve their spoken and written language.

Student Council

The establishment of a Student Council gives students an opportunity to acquire the sort of communication, planning and organisational skills which will be beneficial to them in their future. The purpose of student council is to develop leadership qualities among students by organizing & carrying out school activities & service projects. The newly elected council is endowed with the responsibilities of Head Boy, Head Girl, Sports Boy, Sports Girl, House Captains & Vice Captains and awarded with the badges and sashes.





Transport Facility

To ensure safe travel, the school has its own fleet of school buses designed as per standards and manned by trained bus drivers and conductors to provide safe to and fro journey to the students. All buses are equipped with CCTV cameras for security purpose. If students require the transport facility, kindly fill the "transport form" and submit it to the office.

Rules Governing Transport Facility

- Transport service is an optional service facilitated and outsourced by the school for the convenience of its students.
- The school bus facility available to the student cannot be expected or demanded as a matter of right. The Transport Department at their own discretion has the right to disallow any student from availing the bus facility.
- Students availing the bus facility will be provided with a bus no, pick up and alighting stop no. Generally the bus timings will operate within 10 to 15 minutes of the pickup and alighting time. Parents are requested to accommodate the same.
- Any change in the bus timings will be notified to the parent by the Transport Department.
- Students will have to board and alight the school bus at the respective stops allotted to them only. The Transport Dept reserves the rights to allot the stops.
- Students while traveling on the school bus must maintain discipline. Any student guilty of misconduct will not be allowed to avail the bus facility.
- A student shall be refused the bus facility if involved in damage to the bus property. Besides, the damage done will have to be compensated by the student.
- Discontinuation of bus facility will only be allowed term wise. Bus facility cannot be discontinued for any particular month.
- No transport facility shall be available for other activities / events that school may plan on holidays / vacations.
- Students/ parents will not have any transactions / altercation / physical fight with the bus staff. Bus employees are not authorized to change/add bus stops.
- The school has taken utmost care for the safety and convenience of the students.
- The Transport charges will be paid along with the fee quarterly
- Parents desiring to discontinue bus service are requested to inform the Principal in writing, at least three months in advance, otherwise three months transport charges will have to be paid.

Registration and Admission

1. Registration for new admission to Nursery class starts in the month of December every year.
2. Parents seeking admission of their ward must register the name in advance. Registration for the admission to the other classes depends on the availability of seats and the vacant seats are expected to be very few. Registration does not guarantee admission.
3. No candidate will be admitted without entrance test except for nursery class and the decision of the management will be final in this matter.
4. Those who are seeking admission in any class must produce a date of birth certificate issued by the municipality or equivalent authority.
5. An attested copy of the most recent results available from the present/previous school, if any, should be submitted along with duly filled application forms.
6. The selection of the candidate will be done at the discretion of the management, The parents, guardians, relations and anybody else will have no right to question the procedure of selection of students.
7. Those students who join the school at any time of a current academic year will have to pay the complete fee of that academic year even if they join late.
8. For the selection and admission of any candidate, no request or recommendation will be entertained. In all the matters the decision of the management is final.

Fee Regulation

1. Tuition fees are to be paid for 12 months and will have to be deposited in prescribed dates.
2. The annual fees will be charged every year (Which comprise term fee, library fee, sanitation, hygiene, examination fee, sports and games)
3. The school reserves its right to revise the fees without prior information.

TRUE LIGHT PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL

Rules of Conduct and Discipline

1. The academic session of the school will be from March to February. The medium of instruction and expression is English. Punjabi the Mother tongue is taught from Nursery and Hindi the national language from L.K.G. standard onwards.
2. Both students and parents must read all the rules printed on the school diary and circulars which will be issued from time to time. Ignorance of the rules will not be taken as an excuse for noncompliance.
3. The minimum age of the candidates for the admission to the Nursery is three (3) Years.
4. It is essential that an authentic certificate of the date of birth of the candidate be produced at the time of admission.
5. No student shall be admitted to the school (Class I onwards) without transfer certificate from the school last attended and duly countersigned by the concerned education officer or board.
6. The school reserves the right to suspend or dismiss the students. Irregular attendance, habitual negligence of duty, misbehavior, conduct injurious to the tone of the school, insubordination to the authority and any other type of misconduct is a sufficient reason for the suspension or dismissal of a student.
7. Any kind of damage done to the school property including writing on the wall or on the school furniture must be compensated at the expense of the offender along with the fine that may be imposed by the principal.
8. No refund or exchange will be made once the receipt is issued.
9. No student will be granted leave without prior notice. In all the cases permission is at the discretion of the principal. Those who are absent for 8 consecutive days without the prior permission from the principal are liable to have their names struck off the rolls.
10. The Principal may request parents to withdraw those children in case they do not fit in with the regulations of the school or are not capable of any improvements or if the parents themselves do not co-operate with the school authority.
11. The students are expected to take active participation in the co-curricular activities, educational, tours, picnic etc. arranged by the school.
12. No student will be exempted from P.T. or games unless he/she produces a doctor's certificate showing that he/she is physically unfit to take part in extra curricular activities which is an integral part of their training.
13. Pupils should attend the school regularly. They must reach the school at least five minutes before the assembly. Late comers may not be allowed to attend the session of the day.
14. Every student should bring the school diary daily. All information or request is conveyed to the parents/guardians through the diary by the principal/teachers.
15. Students are not allowed to bring sharp edged instruments, razor blades, valuables, especially golden ornaments. Other books, news papers, periodicals etc are not allowed in the school.
16. No student shall be allowed to go out or to be taken out of the school compound without obtaining the 'out pass' from the principal. The out pass shall not be issued unless the Principal is satisfied with the genuineness of the matter and accompanying person.
17. Parents should see that their child comes to the school with their daily needs like writing materials, tiffin, test books, copies etc.
18. Cleanliness of person and dress is expected of every student. They are supposed to come in full school uniform.
19. Students themselves will be responsible for their own belongings. The school will not entertain any claim for the loss of money, clothes, watches and ornaments etc. however on bringing any such loss to the notice of the principal, inquiry may be conducted. It is advised to mark the name on all his/her belongings.
20. Allotting of Sections/Houses and shuffling, as and when required, is fully at the discretion of the school authorities and no request for a particular section/house or changing of a section / house is entertained, unless it is found very essential.

Examination and Promotion

- School conducts two terminal examinations; 1st term in September and final term in February and two unit examinations in May & December for class one onward.
- For Kindergarten Classes, four unit examinations are conducted in May, September, December and February.
- Promotion is granted on the basis of the whole year's performance of the student. Minimum 40% marks are required for passing the examination.
- Final result is declared in March for all the classes and report/progress cards will be issued to the students.
- No exam will be pre-poned or post-poned unless it is an emergency.
- Students found using unfair means during the examinations will not be allowed to appear for the rest of examinations and strict action will be initiated by the school authorities.

Instructions for the parents

- Parents are expected to attend all the PTM's scheduled by the school.
- Parents are expected to be well mannered, warm & courteous towards teachers, school staff, drivers and the conductors.
- Parents are requested to visit the school/reception only on the stipulated time.
- Parents are not allowed to contact the school staff on their personal contact numbers or visit their homes under any circumstances.
- If the parents wish to meet school staff they must contact the school to seek prior appointment.
